Pt. Stanley, Falkland Islands. Situated near Cape Horn in South America, the harbor at Stanley is one of the world's largest shipping graveyards of the 19th century. Many of the ships that set out for faraway ports met their destiny here, battered by Cape Horn's treacherous waters. One of the best ports to see penguins!

Thursday, February 17 B,L,D

Cape Horn. Cape Horn, the southernmost tip of South America, is where sailors on epic journeys are tested. The rough waters and prevailing winds make this region a place of great beauty and danger. Many attempts to "round the Horn" have failed and it has been reported that some 800 ships and 10,000 sailors have gone down trying.

The route around Cape Horn, prior to the Panama Canal and the transcontinental railroad, was important for trade and passenger ships taking goods and people from either coasts of the United States. Sailing ships had to battle the elements for extended periods, some never being able to round the Horn and forced to turn back or perish. The waters were so treacherous that ships passed this way for centuries before discovering Antarctica, a mere 90 miles to the south. It's a breathtaking journey to round the Horn.

Friday, February 18 B,L,D

Ushuaia, Argentina. Ushuaia is the southernmost city in the world and one of two main cities on the island territory of Tierra del Fuego. Shared by Argentina and Chile, "The Land of Fire" features unforgettable scenery and trails of discovery framed by the sea, forests, lakes and mountains.

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Saturday, February 19 B,L,D

Punta Arenas, Chile. Punta Arenas lies atop rolling hills, looking out over the Straits of Magellan. In the days before the Panama Canal, this was a major port as ships plied the waters of Cape Horn. The city is also the gateway to Chilean Patagonia, a maze of fjords, rivers, steppes and mountains to the north.

Post-Cruise

Wednesday, February 23 B, L

Disembark Star Princess. After clearing immigration enjoy a full-day tour featuring the old district of Valparaíso, the garden city of Viña del Mar and Santiago de Chile. Lunch and wine tasting included. Transfer to Santiago airport after tour.

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Iguazu Falls Pre-cruise Option

Imagine over 250 separate waterfalls tumbling over a horseshoe precipice of over two miles. This is thundering Iguazu Falls, truly one of the world's greatest natural wonders.

The falls are shared by the Iguazú National Park, a UNESCO World Heritage Sites full of exotic subtropical vegetation that surrounds the falls. There are nearly 2,000 plant species – different kinds of giant trees, ferns, lianas, orchids – and 400 bird species – parrots and toucans among them – as well as jaguars, caimans, and more.

Saturday, February 5 D

Arrive RIO (Rio de Janeiro airport). Transfer to Sheraton Rio. Great location between famed Ipanema Beach and Barra da Tijuca. Enjoy a leisurely afternoon shopping or visiting the beaches. This evening a welcome dinner. Get acquainted with your fellow solos!

Sunday, February 6 B

Transfer to airport and fly to Iquazu and then transfer to Hotel das Cataratas, located inside Iguazu National Park.

This afternoon, see the lower falls by boat on a Macuco Safari. We will travel along the river onboard a boat to the base of the Iguazu Falls where we will have the opportunity to admire them up close. The whirlpools, waves and currents created by the Falls give an adrenaline rush that adds to this unforgettable tour.

Monday, February 7 B

Today we head for the Argentinean side of Iguazu Falls. In order to get to the catwalks to see the Falls, we will board a gas-propelled train, that will take us to the upper falls circuit and the Devil's Throat. After disembarking at Devil's Throat Station, it is approximately a 1,100-meter walk on a flat catwalk, built over the Upper Iguazu River and crossing several islands. At the end of the catwalks, is the strategic lookout point resting on the side of the gorgeous Devil's Throat.

Tuesday, February 8 B, D

Transfer to airport and return to Rio, staying again at the Sheraton Rio. Great location between famed Ipanema Beach and Barra da Tijuca. Enjoy a leisurely afternoon shopping or visiting the beaches.

This evening we enjoy Brazilian barbeque and a fabulous Samba show at the world renowned Plataforma 01.
